About IAYP

The Duke of Edinburgh’s Award is the world’s leading achievement award for young people. It is voluntary, non-competitive and available to anyone aged 14-24. Young people design their own Award programme, set their own goals and record their own progress. The only person they compete against is themselves, by challenging their own beliefs about what they can achieve.

Enrollment for this programme is voluntary and is not a binding on any student. The school will guide and facilitate all students who enroll for this Award programme.

Operational Principle

Age range: 14 -25 years
Balanced Programme of 4 mandatory sections :
Physical Recreation, Skills, Service and Expeditions

3 Levels

Bronze
Silver
Gold

The Award has four sections designed to provide a balanced programme of personal development. These sections are:

- Service: which aims to understand the value of giving service to others and their community.
- Skills: encouraging development of personal interests, creativity or practical skills.
- Physical recreation: encouraging participation in sport and other physical recreation for the improvement of health and fitness.
- Adventure Journey: encouraging a spirit of adventure and discovery whilst undertaking a journey in a group.

There is an additional requirement to complete a Residential Project to successfully complete the Gold Level. The details for the Adventure Journey and the residential project are awaited in the light of the pandemic. However, changes have been made to the programme to ensure students can work on it while they are at home.

As the Award is a programme of individual challenge, participants are encouraged to work at their own pace. However, on average, participants should be spending at least one hour per week on their chosen activity. The Award cannot be achieved in a shorter time span by working more intensely; the objective is to develop a sense of commitment to a given task over time. Participants must persist for at least these minimum periods:

BRONZE	6 months	Not Applicable
SILVER	12 months	6 months (if Bronze holder)
GOLD	18 months	12 months (if Silver holder)
